POINT: "What is the book about?"

It is about the acknowledgement of a sinister presence among "the beloved".

PURPOSE: "Why was the book written?"

To equip, direct & encourage those who are beloved by God to contend & continue in their most holy faith despite clandestine nefarious activity.

PRACTICAL APPLICATION: "How does this affect my life personally?"

4. If God will faithfully judge, what am I to do? (vss. 3, 17, 20-23)
